The monetary proceeds will be sent to Long Island Cares Food Bank to continue our focus on helping those who are in need of supplies resulting from the hurricane disasters. The winner MUST be present with the valid purchased ticket, and the ticket winner will be announced nearing the end of the intermission, before the second half of the show continues.
