

BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board of Education may, from time to time, establish sub-committees whose membership will consist of less than a quorum of members of the Board of Education. The president of the Board of Education and the Superintendent of Schools shall serve as ex-officio members of all committees to which they are not appointed. The duties of Board of Education committees shall be outlined at the time of appointment. Board of Education committees shall undertake studies and make reports as charged by the Board of Education, but shall not act on behalf of the Board of Education. The Board of Education may establish standing or ad hoc committees and reserves the right to terminate any committees at any time.

Any official policy-level action shall be in the sole discretion of the Board of Education. The Board of Education is in no way obligated to follow committee recommendations. The Board of Education has the right to accept, reject, or modify all or any part of a committee recommendation.
