

FLAG DISPLAYS

The Building Principal shall see that the United States flag is prominently and permanently displayed in public areas of the school. The flag displayed shall measure no less than 12x18 inches if in a frame, or 2x3 feet if on a flagstaff.

The United States flag shall be displayed on a flagpole on the school grounds at all times during days while school is in session. The flag displayed shall measure no less than 3x5 feet in size.

Traditional customs and practices of displaying the flag of the United States shall be observed. Flags shall be handled with respect at all times.

The United States flag or any depiction or representation of the flag displayed for public view and permanently attached to any part of school buildings or grounds shall conform to federal laws regarding flag displays and use. However, temporary displays of instructional or historical materials or student work products used as part of a lesson that includes the flag shall be allowed even if they do not conform with federal law as long as they are not permanently affixed or attached.
