

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

In order to maintain an educational environment conducive to learning, the Board of Education may restrict or prohibit conduct, which is disorderly, insubordinate, dangerous or otherwise disruptive. A determination of what constitutes prohibited conduct should be within the discretion of the Board and in compliance with applicable laws.
